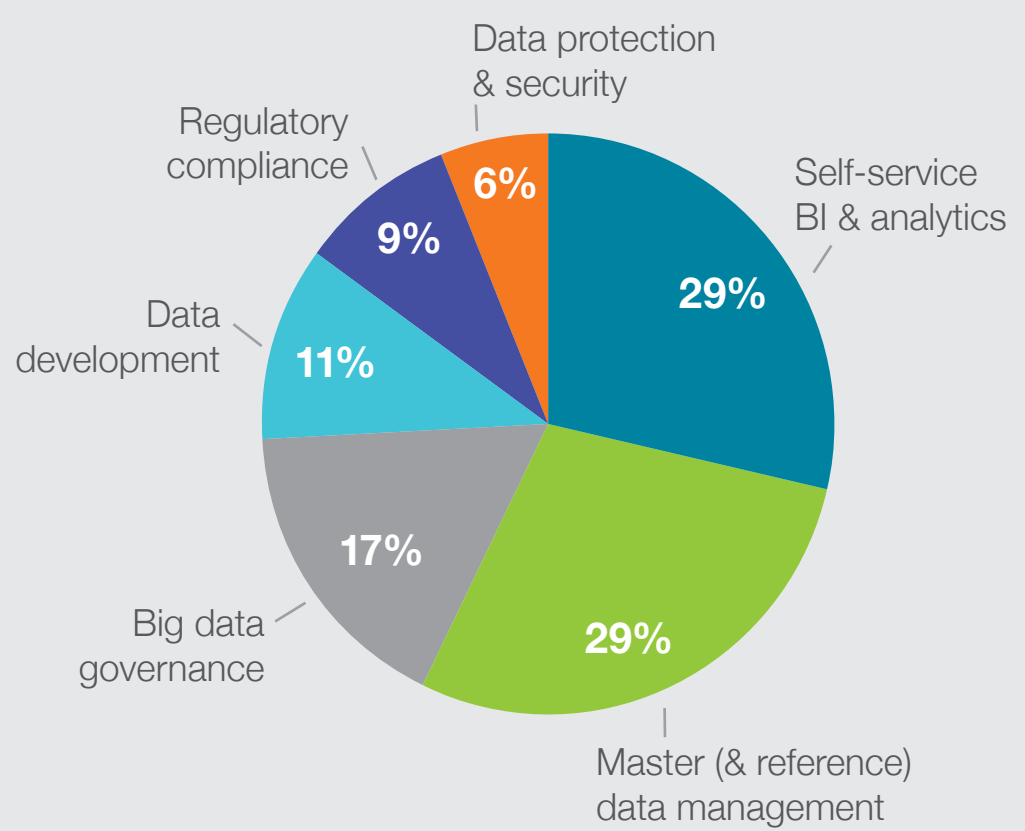

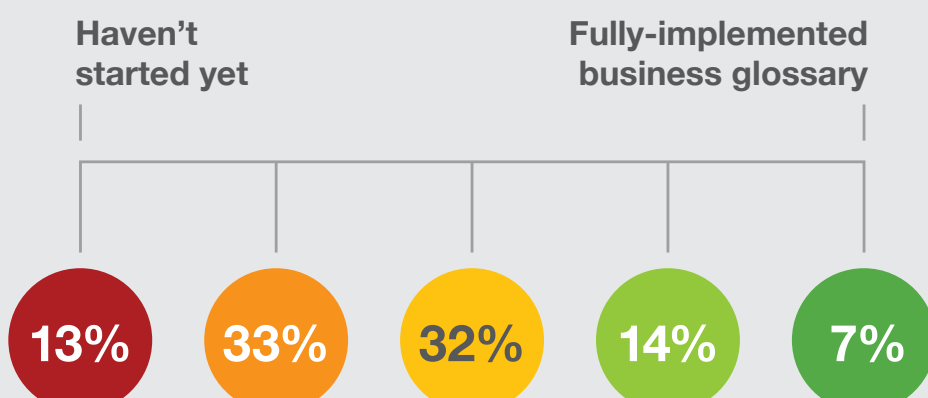

It's Still Early

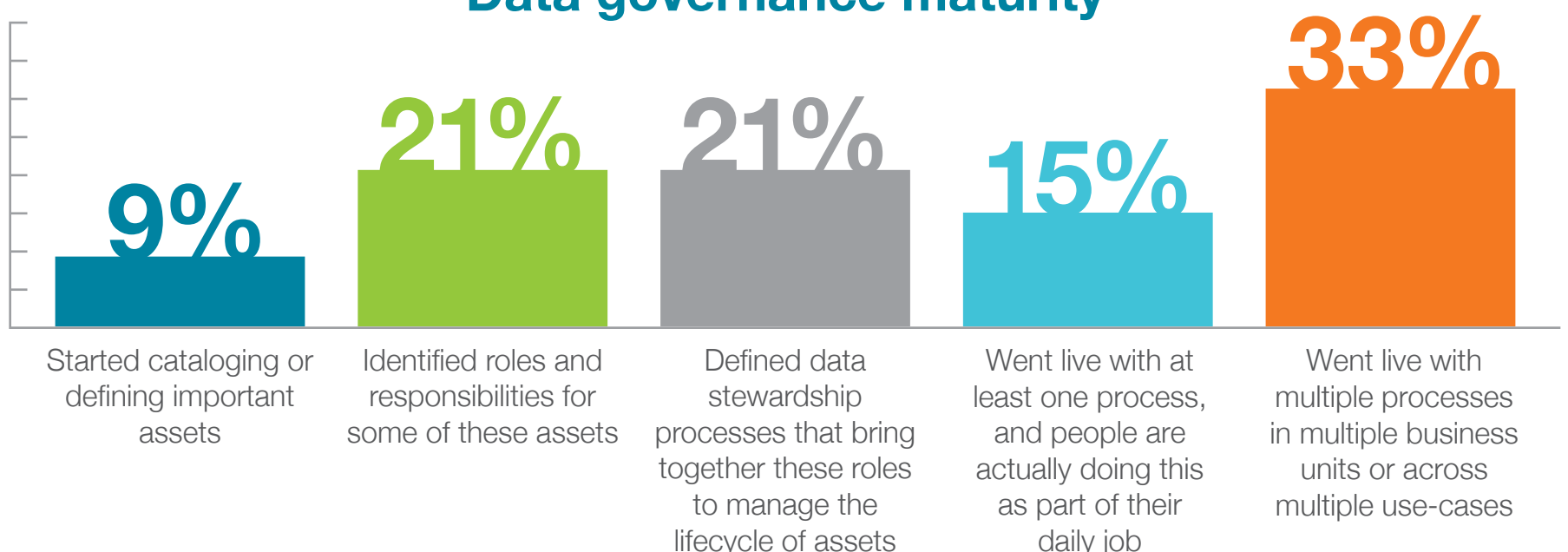
Many organizations are still implementing a business glossary

Data governance maturity



Reaching a level of maturity where you have multiple processes in place across multiple business units or use cases takes time. Only one-third of respondents believe they've reached this level of maturity. Many more organizations are earlier on in their data governance journey.
